

**CLEAR DIVIDE** For those not ready to embrace an open approach, a minimalist sliding glass screen can provide the best of both worlds. Made from a single panel of toughened glass, which is set on smooth glide runners hidden in the top support frame, this door would cost around £1,500 from IQ Glass, 01494 722880, iqglassuk.com. ▶



**PRIVACY SCREEN** A centrally positioned stud wall is a good solution if you want to screen the WC and bidet from the bedroom. It will also conceal all the pipework that is necessary for a sleek wall-hung vanity.
