



◀ This rear extension designed by HUT Architecture using slim framed aluminium sliding doors and structural glass roof above with minimal steel supports. To the side a frameless 'picture window' allows light in from the side.



▲ A frameless glass box extension using low iron glass beams and fins with slim framed aluminium sliding doors as access to the garden.

GLAZING PROJECTS



▲ Renovation and extension works designed by Found Associates. The main focus of the project was this linear extension with cantilevered roof. Beneath frameless structural glass runs down the full side of the living space with a single thin framed sliding doors as access to the garden areas.

▶ A kitchen extension with full sized sliding doors. The slim framed aluminium doors have a flush floor finish and slide away into the white wall to leave a fully open façade to the kitchen with flush floor finishes across the tracks to the large gardens. Above a structural glass roof allows in vertical light and a frameless picture window grants light in from the side.
